***Important new* Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Guidelines from American Heart Association recommend the use of commercially available endotracheal-tube holders over the common techniques of taping and tying.**

Respiratory Therapists & Nurses could benefit from less complex systems, since they are the individuals who apply the device to the patient.

The primary benefits of a commercially available endotracheal-tube stabilizer are:

- Aids in the reduction in the occurrence of accidental extubation.
- Ease of putting the device on the patient in emergency and nonemergency situations
- Latex-Free, the biocompatibility of the holder with the patient's skin
- Ease of moving the tube from side to side to permit access to the oral cavity
- Compatibility of the device with MRI machines
- Low cost of the device
- Easy locking and unlocking of the mechanism used to secure the tube without occluding the tube.
- Broad, soft surface that protects the patient's facial skin from pressure points while minimizing skin damage
